Pisansky, Esq., appearing), attorneys for petitioner New Jersey Property-Liability Insurance Guaranty Association ("NJPUIGA") by way of verified complaint, Certification of John Burke, Esq., and Affidavit of Lori Connors, Esq., Chief Operating Officer of NJPLIGA, and the court having entered an order to show cause with temporary restraints staying all proceedings in the State of New Jersey where Vesta Fire Insurance Company ("Vesta") or Shelby Casualty Insurance Company ("Shelby") is a party or is obligated to defend a party until October 12, 2006, at which time all objections to the entry of an order staying such proceedings for a period of 120 days nunc pro tune to August 1, 2006, would be heard, and the court having considered the papers in support of the order, and the court having heard oral argument, and the court having otherwise received no objection to the entry of an order generally staying all such proceedings pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:30A-18, and for good cause having been shown and due deliberation having been had herein, and the court's reasons having been expressed on the record of the court,

ORDERED that a copy of this order shall be published in the New Jersey Law Journal, the New Jersey Lawyer, the Newark Star Ledger, the Courier Post and The Asbury Park Press
