**THIS MATTER** having been opened to the court on October 23, 2003 by Addas, Berlin, Kaplan, Dembling, Burke & Potenza, F.A., (John Burke, Esq., appearing), attorneys for petitioner New Jersey Property-Liability Insurance Guaranty Association ("NJPIIGA") by way of verified complaint, Certification of John Burke, Esq., and Affidavit of Lori Connors, Esq., Claims Manager of NJPIIGA, and the court having entered an order to show cause with temporary restraints staying all proceedings in the State of New Jersey where Legion Insurance Company ("Legion") or Villanova Insurance Company ("Villanova") is a party or is obligated to defend a party until October 23, 2003, at which time all objections to the entry of an order staying such proceedings for a period of 120 days *nunc pro tunc* to July 25, 2003, would be heard, and the court having considered the papers in support of the order, as well as papers submitted by counsel in certain proceedings requesting relief from any proposed stay, and the court having entered orders exempting the following proceedings from the stay provisions of this order:

1. *We Elnak, Inc. vs. Wilson, et al.*, Docket No.: CAM-L-8370-02;
2. *Effenberger vs. Rentz & Morano*, Docket No.: MON-L-4013-00;
3. *Desmarois vs. HRI Acquisition Corp.*, U.S.D.C. Civil Action No.: 01-4121 (FLW);

and the court having further entered an order exempting from the matter of *DiDanna vs. Sher-  
Del Transfer and Relocation Service, et al*, Doccket No.: MON-L-850-02 for the limited purpose  
of conducting certain specific discovery, and the court having otherwise received no objection  
to the entry of an order generally staying all such proceedings pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:30A-18,  
and for good cause having been shown and due deliberation having been had herein, and the  
court's reasons having been expressed on the record of the court,


ORDERED that all proceedings pending in the State of New Jersey in which Legion or  
Villanova is a party or is obligated to defend a party, not otherwise exempted from the  
provisions of this order by separate order of this court, are hereby stayed until November 22,  
2003, and it is further,

ORDERED that any request for a further stay of any such proceeding shall be made by  
motion filed by counsel for the party seeking the stay, in the county in which that proceeding is  
pending, on notice to all parties to that proceeding and to NJFLIGA, and it is further,

ORDERED that all such motions shall be decided by the Civil Presiding Judge of the  
vicinage in which the motion is filed, or that Judge designated by the Civil Presiding Judge, and  
it is further,

ORDERED that a copy of this order shall be served upon the Civil Presiding Judge and  
the Civil Division Manager of each vicinage in this state on or before OCTOBER 31, 2003, and it  
is further,

ORDERED that a copy of this order shall be published in the New Jersey Law Journal,  
NOVEMBER 7,  
the New Jersey Lawyer, the Newark Star Ledger and the Courier Post no later than 2003.
