THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by Addas, Berlin, Kaplan, Dembling, Burke & Potenza, P.A. (John Burke, Esq. appearing), attorneys for petitioner New Jersey Property Liability Insurance Guaranty Association, ("NJPLIGA"), by way of certification of Mr. Burke dated January 24, 2002 and affidavit of Lori A. Connors, Esq., claims manager of NJPLIGA dated January 25, 2002, requesting that the court enter an order further staying such proceedings pending in the courts of New Jersey where Reliance is a party or is obligated to defend a party and where NJPLIGA, having certain statutory obligations with respect to such proceedings, has not come into possession of the Reliance files partaining to such matters, for a period of 120 days beginning February 1, 2002, and the court having set March 22, 2002 as the return date for the order to show cause at which time all objections to the relief sought by petitioner would be heard, and the court having considered the aforementioned submissions on behalf of petitioner, and the court having been supplied with a list of those cases pending in New Jersey's courts where NJPLIGA had received the Reliance file as of February 19, 2002, and the court having heard the argument of counsel for petitioner on March 22, 2002, and due deliberation having been had herein, and for good cause being shown,

## IT IS ON THIS 2212 DAY OF MARCHA, 2002;

ORDERED that all proceedings currently pending in the courts of the State of New Jersey in which Reliance Insurance Company is a party or is obligated to defend a party, are heraby stayed until April 22, 2002, with the exception of those cases specified in the list provided by NJPLIGA to this court on February 19, 2002, which list has been supplied to the civil case managers and Civil Presiding Judges of each vicinage of the state, and it is further;

made by motion filed by counsel for the party in such a proceeding seeking the stay, filed in the county in which that proceeding is pending, on notice to all parties to that proceeding and to NJPLIGA, and it is further

ORDERED all such motions shall be decided by the Civil Presiding Judge of the vicinage in which the motion is filled, of that judge designated by the Civil Presiding Judge, and it is further

ORDERED that all counsel currently representing a party which Reliance Insurance Company is, or was, obligated to provide a defense shall forthwith provide notice to NJPL GA, if such notice has not already been provided, of the fact of that representation, the title of the case, the docket number, the identity of the Reliance insured, and such other information as shall assist NJPLIGA in identifying the lawsuit, identifying the Reliance file, and determining and discharging its obligations to the Reliance insured, and it is further

ORDERED that all counsel currently representing a party in any such proceeding, for which party Reliance Insurance Company is or was obligated to provide a defense shall supply notice, if such notice has not already been supplied, to the Civil Presiding Judge
